

Forest Stewardship Tree Farmer of the Year 2010

Eligibility and Guidelines:

- State Forest Stewardship Landowner and Outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year Awards are combined into one award.
- Must be a certified member of the American Tree Farm System(ATFS).
- Must have a Forest Stewardship Management Plan.
- The award will follow the guidelines of the ATFS's Outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year Competition which will also serve as the standards for Forest Stewardship recognition. Guidelines are found in the current ATFS Leadership Handbook, Section 5.1.1, pages 130-132.
- Landowner's property must be located in the eastern or central KFS districts.
- Applications of nominees who do not receive the award will be kept on file as official nominations for the following year. The Rural Forestry Coordinator will be responsible for updating these nominations.

Awards Materials:

- A sign will be presented to the winner each year that includes Forest Stewardship, Tree Farm and KFS logos, award title, landowner's name and year of the award. An 8' treated 4' x 4" post will also be provided.
- In addition to the sign, an outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year plaque (includes a brass plate that must be engraved with the winner's name), and a \$350 STIHL gift certificate will be presented to the award winner.
- The award will be presented by the State Forester, Kansas State Tree Farm Committee Chair and STIHL representative at the Fall Forestry Field Day.
- The Rural Forestry Coordinator is responsible for awards materials and placing the awards order with ATFS a minimum of 30 days prior to the Fall Forestry Field Day.

Nomination Procedure:

- Kansas Forest Service foresters, members of ATFS, Forest Stewardship landowners and Kansas State Tree Farm Committee members are all invited to submit nominations for the Forest Stewardship Tree Farmer of the Year.
- To qualify, nominations must be received at the Kansas Forest Service State Office by January 31st.
- Using the ATFS's Checklist for Judging the Outstanding Tree Farm of the Year guidelines (Section 5.30, pages 136-137 in current Leadership Handbook), the Kansas State Tree Farm Committee will select the award winner during their February meeting by majority vote.

Promotion:

- The Rural Forestry Coordinator is responsible for promoting the award and award winners.
- The Rural Forestry Coordinator will nominate the Forest Stewardship Tree Farmer of the Year for the KWF Forest Conservationist CAP award by December 20th.
